We will be building respect for diversity, valuing others' beliefs and respect for others.

As geographers, we will explain some of the main things that are in hot and cold places and the clothes that we would need wear in hot and cold places. We will also explain how the weather changes throughout the year and name the seasons.

In PSHE, we will explore how we are special, friends and family, how to get along and what to do when you feel angry.

As writers, we will continue to correctly use full stops, capital letters and question marks. We will also be exploring different characters and how they are feeling. We will also be learning to join two sentences together with 'and'.

As scientists, we will name a variety of animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. We will sort animals into categories (including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals).

As musicians, we will be following the 'Charanga' scheme practise keeping the beat. We will learn to improvise using repeated patterns and perform a simple part rhythmically. We will also be learning songs for our Christmas Performance.

As mathematicians, we will count in steps of 2, 5 & 10 from 0, and forward & backwards from numbers to 100. We will read numbers to 100 and write numbers in words to 20. We will add and subtract and learn about shapes.

As artists and designers, we will create moods in art work. We will use pencils to create lines of different thickness in drawings. We will also learn to name the primary and secondary colours.

As athletes, we will develop our co-ordination skills and team work skills. We will focus on reflecting on our own skills and pushing ourselves through challenges. We will also focus on fitness, stamina and keeping healthy.

As Gymnasts, we will make our bodies curled, tense, stretched and relaxed. We will control our bodies when travelling and relaxing and copy sequences and repeat them. We will learn to roll, curl, travel and balance in different ways.

As readers, we will explore quality topic themed stories and poems. We will continue to develop our decoding (phonics) skills alongside skills of inference, predicting and summarising.

In RE, We will be learning about Christianity and how and why Christmas is celebrated.
