


Why does chocolate taste so good?

Promoting British Values



As integrated with topic work, we will focus on having respect for ourselves including the body we live in and how to keep safe and healthy throughout our lives. We shall also endeavour to promote how others should respect themselves and their bodies.

As scientists, we are looking at how the digestive system works and what happens to food as it travels through the body. Additionally, we will look at teeth in humans and animals and then move on to study animal food chains.

As writers, we will be writing a narrative based piece from our book, The Incredible Book Eating Boy. As this is a picture book, we will focus on the inference of what would have been written if it was a full length story book.

As mathematicians, we will focus on number work from place value, ordering numbers, negative numbers through to working on the number operations of addition and subtraction. Pupils will find it beneficial to work on counting and practising times tables this year.

As computer programmers, pupils will develop their coding skills from Year 3 and explore the different techniques required to build a game including creating variables and debugging any errors.

In PSHE, we will be looking at self-belief and issues that affect us in society.

As artists, we will be developing our sketching skills by learning to use different sketching pencils to develop shade and texture.

We will then go on to create a piece of art and evaluate it.

As designers, we are going designing our own chocolate product including the packaging to sell at the Farmer's Market event. This is the fundamental element to our topic this term.

As Spanish speakers, pupils will build on their speaking skills from last year and understanding more phraseology and interpret stories in Spanish this term.

As athletes, we will develop our invasion and ball game skills through football. Pupils will explore the different techniques to possess and control the ball and work on teambuilding skills.

In RE, we will explore worship and the community, focusing on the Hindu and Christian religions.
